HEAT POLICY - REFERENCE: CLUB HEAT POLICY

ATTENTION: ALL COACHING STAFF, TEAM MANAGERS AND FIRST AID OFFICERS

Football Victoria have released their Extreme Weather Policy for all Clubs to adhere to. After a committee meeting, we have summarized it, creating the below Club rules. We will attach a copy of the FV Extreme Weather Policy for your reference.

1. On an occasion where temperatures are HIGH, Team Managers will be informed whether training sessions will be cancelled, no later than 4pm. This will be communicated by the committee, on the decision made by our Club Risk Management / Insurance / Safety Officer.
2. This applies to players 16 years of age and under (including 16 yrs.'), as players above 16 yrs.' old are regarded as adults.
3. The decision made will be based on the WBGT (Wet Bulb Globe Temperature) taken from BOM (Bureau of Meteorology) at 4pm.
4. The affected training times will be between 5pm and 7.20pm. In the event where the 7.30pm training time slot will be affected; we will advise accordingly.
5. For children 11 years and under, the WBGT must not exceed 26. For players between 12 and 18 years the WBGT must not exceed 29.
6. NPL U14s and U15s may use an alternative venue from 7.30pm on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays only.
7. Coaching Staff MUST give players extra drink breaks and it is the responsibility of the player to ensure they have ample amounts of water.
8. It is also the responsibility of the players to apply sun tan lotion if they wish.
9. Each team must have a first aid officer present at training, on days of hot weather.
